#### EDNA TOWNSHIP MEETING May 18, 2021 www.ednatownship.org

The meeting was called to order and began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dennis Sazama, Gary Schattschneider, Ben Bucholz, Echo Dockter and Karen Marthaler were present.

The agenda was reviewed. Sazama made a motion to approve the agenda with the addition of Ditch 25 under Road Report. Bucholz 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and it passed unanimously.

The Clerk's report was reviewed. Sazama made a motion to accept the clerk's report as written. Schattschneider 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and it passed unanimously.

The Treasurer's report showed receipts of \$19.99, disbursements of \$9,288.74, and working capital of \$1,210,101.59.

Sazama made a motion to accept the report as presented. Bucholz 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and it passed unanimously.

Andy Moenkedick brought in 82 gophers. He was added to the claims for payment and paid at the meeting.

Claims for payment were discussed. The invoices from Dora were reviewed in more detail but agreed to pay as presented. Schattschneider made a motion to pay the claims as presented. Sazama 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and it passed unanimously.

The road report began with the request from Harold Overland for an access permit. Schattschneider made a motion to approve, Sazama 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and it passed unanimously.

The property owners on Teal Lane would like this made into a township road, and to have it asphalted. Stabnow will inspect the road to see what would be required to bring this up to township specs. It should be noted that this is a platted road. Sazama made a motion to authorize Stabnow to inspect the road. Schattschneider 2<sup>nd</sup> it and the motion passed unanimously.

Stabnow has inspected 378th Ave (Mark Lenius road). This is a platted road. Some of it is already asphalted. Stabnow stated that the other part of the road would have to have the vegetation removed and then be tested to confirm the compaction. Once confirmed the township road specs require 4" of gravel and then asphalt. Stabnow and Lenius will work together to get the road up to spec. There was a discussion of the cul-de-sac at the east end of the road. This could be changed to a T as long as the snowplow contractor agrees. At this time it is a cul-de-sac and the plan is to leave it that way. Sazama made a motion to have Stabnow inspect the road after the vegetation is removed, and again after the class 5 is on and to include an inspection of the shoulder material. There was also a request to make sure the right-of-way is clear of trees.

Chloride has been approved for the usual list (Kerbs, Devils Lake, 380<sup>th</sup> and 355th). Fort Thunder and Sybil Lake were added at the April meeting. The chloride for Sybil Lake should cover about ½ mile, to include 34226 and 34252 and one more house to the west of these. The motion from April should cover this. This discussion just clarified the specific area to be covered.

There is interest in having West Little McDonald, also known as Kerbs Lake Road, asphalted. This road already is a township road so the policy states the township is responsible for bringing the base up to the correct condition to be asphalted. The property owners along the asphalted length then share the cost of the asphalt 50/50, with the township. Stabnow will put together an estimate of the cost to get the road up to asphalting readiness. Schattschneider made a motion to approve Stabnow's costs to do the estimate. Bucholz 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and it passed unanimously.

The quotes for repairing E Big McDonald Dr were opened. See attached report. Central Specialties had the lowest quote. Sazama made a motion to award the project to Central Specialties. Schattschneider 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and it passed unanimously. Note that engineering costs will hold at \$16, 876 as stated by Stabnow.

Schattschneider made a motion to have Stabnow pull together an estimate to repair N Little McDonald from Wenzel's to the corner of 385<sup>th</sup>. Bucholz 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and it passed unanimously.

There will be quotes for repairing 455<sup>th</sup> St, also known as the Castle House Road, at the June meeting. The dip in the road at the corner of 395<sup>th</sup> and 450<sup>th</sup> (by the Krueger house) will be fixed by the sub-contractor. CH131 was discussed. It was agreed that nothing will be done to change 430<sup>th</sup> at this time.

The Board agreed to move the discussion of the minimum maintenance roads to June.

Minimum Maintenance roads – the 3 listed on the 4/17/2012 Resolution are:

363<sup>rd</sup> – one mile from 460<sup>th</sup> St to Grunard Lake 380<sup>th</sup> Ave from 403<sup>rd</sup> Ave to State Highway 108, .75 mile Minnesota St from 380<sup>th</sup> Ave to County Highway 123, 1 mile

The County Road 34 project is causing extra traffic on Fort Thunder Road. Part of this road is in Perham Township and about 1 mile is in Edna Township. Edna just added gravel to the road this Spring because it was worn and in anticipation of the extra load it would be carrying while County Road 34 was being rebuilt. Fort Thunder Road is extremely dusty. It seems the County is now willing to help with dust control on Fort Thunder. Sazama will be negotiating with the County to get the whole road sprayed with chloride. Schattschneider made a motion to give Sazama the authority to commit to the grading of all of Fort Thunder and the application of chloride, and the authority to oversee the coordination of the work with Perham Township and the County. Bucholz seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Sazama worked with an attorney to get a proper form letter formalizing permission for the township to clear the road right-of-way. It is still strongly recommended that there is a conversation with each property owner.

Sazama has a call into Lake and Resources regarding the septic system mound that is in the road right of way. He will report at the June meeting. Dockter found that none of the surrounding townships have a septic system policy.

There was some discussion about Ditch 25. This is a county issue and the township has no authority over the ditch. Unfinished business remaining:

Traffic control

Traffic sign inventory – old signs from Bill Norris' property have been moved to the storage unit.

Proposed schedules for continuing maintenance – copies of gravel invoices from 2017, 2018 and 2019 have been made

Review Access Permit procedures

A resolution was made by Bucholz and seconded by Sazama to change the supervisor compensation to \$400 per month beginning with May 2021, to pay supervisors every month, beginning with June 2021 and to drop the meal reimbursement section. This passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:45 pm.

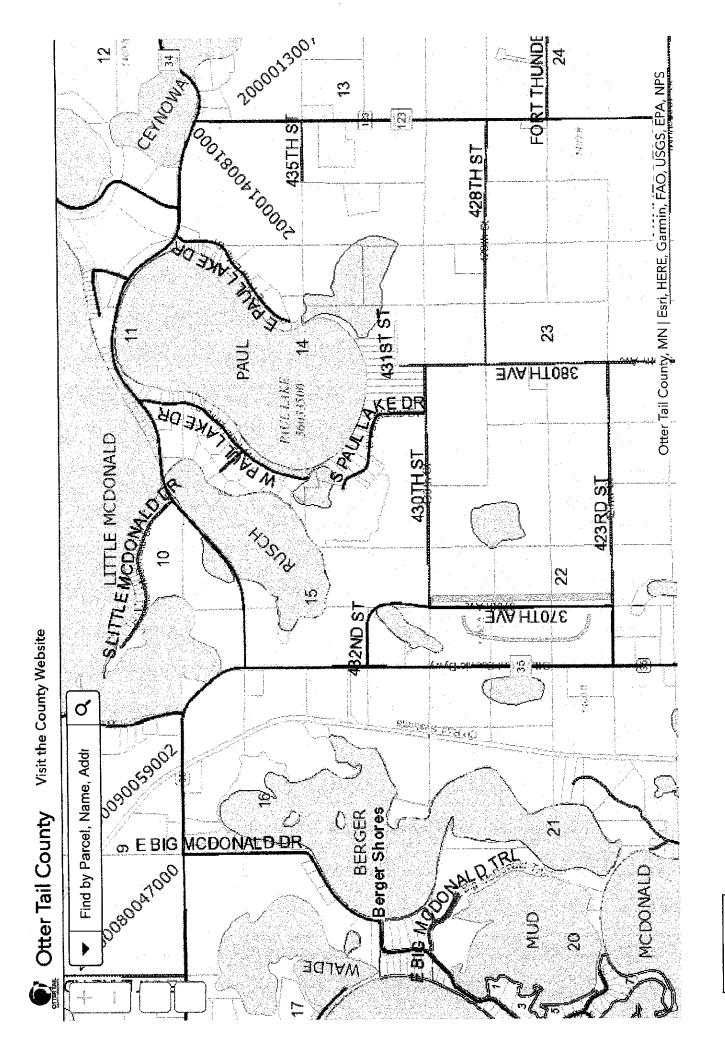

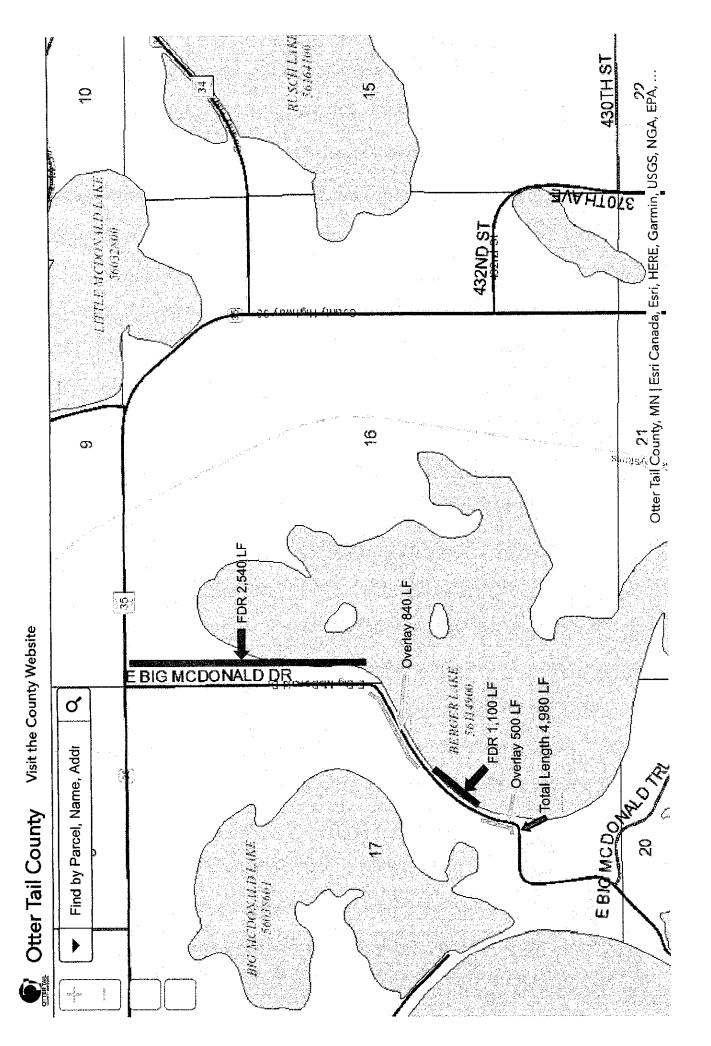

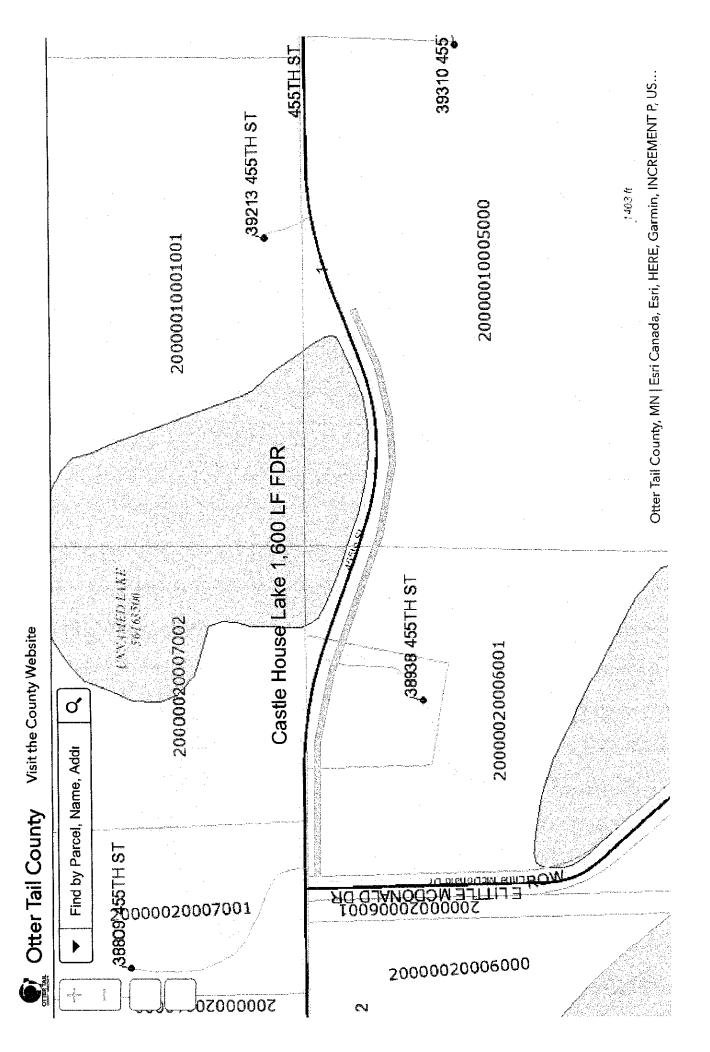

# Resolution Regarding Compensation and Reimbursement of Edna Township Officers Replacing all Resolution regarding compensation prior to this one.

**WHEREAS**, Minn. Stat. § 367.05 directs the Town Board to set compensation of supervisors, town assessors, the treasurer, clerk, deputy clerk, if one is employed, deputy treasurer, if one is employed, and the other employees of the town;

**WHEREAS**, Minn. Stat. § 367.05 indicates the above mentioned persons are entitled to mileage for the use of their own automobile at a rate determined by the Town Board for necessary travel on official town business;

**WHEREAS,** Minn. Stat. § 471.665 subd. 1 directs the Town Board to set the maximum amount which the town shall pay to any officer or employee as compensation or reimbursement for the use of their own automobile in the performance of their duties for the town;

**WHEREAS**, Minn. Stat. § 471.665, subd. 3 allows the Town Board to establish a monthly or periodic allowance for use by officers or employees of their own automobile in the performance of their duties for the town in lieu of the mileage allowance;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Town Board of Edna Township, Otter Tail County, Minnesota hereby adopts the following policy regarding compensation and reimbursement of Town Officers:

#### TOWN OFFICER COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT POLICY

- 1. **Definitions.** For the purpose of this policy, the following terms shall have the meaning given them in this section.
- 1.1Town. "Town" means Edna Township, Otter Tail County, Minnesota
- **1.2 Town Board or Board.** "Town Board" or "Board" means the Town Board of Supervisors of Edna Township, Otter Tail County, Minnesota.
- **1.3 Town Officers.** "Town Officers" means the supervisors, clerk, treasurer, deputy clerk, and deputy treasurer of Edna Township, Otter Tail County, Minnesota.
- **2. Compensation.** The following establishes the basis on which Town Officers shall be compensated for performing services within the scope of their duties for the town.

- **2.1 Meetings.** Towns Officers shall be compensated as follows; Supervisors \$400 per month; Clerk \$500 per month; Treasurer \$400 per month; Deputy Clerk \$65 per meeting; Deputy Treasurer \$65 per meeting. The Deputy Clerk and Deputy Treasurer shall only be eligible for compensation if they are attending the meeting to perform the official duties of the Clerk or Treasurer in their absence. The change in Supervisor pay is effective for May 2021.
- **2.2 Taxes and Withholdings.** All amounts paid to the Town Officers as compensation shall be subject to all appropriate taxes and withholdings as provided by law.
- **3. Reimbursement of Expenses.** The following establishes the rate at which Town Officers shall be reimbursed for expenses they are authorized by the Board to incur and actually incur on behalf of, and within the scope of their duties for the town. Only expenses authorized by the Board are eligible for reimbursement.
- **3.1 Mileage.** When it is necessary and authorized by the Board for the Town Officers to use private automobiles to perform their duties on behalf of the town, Town Officers shall be eligible to have their mileage reimbursed for the actual miles traveled at the established federal standard mileage rate for business use of an automobile in effect at the time of the travel. Town Officers are NOT eligible for mileage reimbursement for attending regular or special board meetings, hearings or annual or special town meetings held within the Town. The mileage reimbursement is inclusive of all direct and indirect automobile related expenses and no other reimbursement for the use of a private automobile shall be allowed.
- **3.2 Telephone.** A Town Officer authorized by the Board to make long-distance calls from their private land line phone to conduct town business shall be eligible to seek reimbursement of the actual costs of making the calls. The costs of using cellular or mobile phones to make long distance calls are not eligible for reimbursement unless specifically authorized by the Board.
- **3.**3 **Other expenses.** Other expenses actually incurred by Town Officers in the performance of their duties for the Town, but which are not addressed in this policy, shall only be eligible for reimbursement if the Board authorized the activity and the expenses where necessary to and arose out of properly conducting Town Business.
- **4. Detailed Claims.** No officer shall receive compensation or be reimbursed for expenses incurred unless and until they submit a written claim report to the Board

detailing the activities supporting the claim for compensation and the specific basis for all expense reimbursement requests. Claims for compensation or requests for the reimbursement of expenses shall be made on Board approved forms. These claims must be submitted to the Clerk 7 days before the next following regular board meeting.

- **4.1 Receipts.** Reimbursement requests for purchases must be supported by original receipts or, if not available, other supporting documentation found sufficient by the Board.
- **5. Amendments.** The Board may amend this policy by resolution.
